(Monday Waiting to see the Oncologist)

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today we had the long-awaited appointment with the oncologist, Dr. Diogo Rosa. Our dear friends Ricardo and Dave accompanied us to the appointment, and we were very grateful for their company and support.

Although we understand the seriousness of Craig's condition, we left the consultation feeling reassured and well cared for. We were very encouraged by the doctor's approach and the clarity with which he explained the treatment plan.

Medical Update

As we had previously been informed, the urothelial carcinoma is not confined to one area of the kidney. It has also affected some lymph nodes and surrounding structures.

Because of this, Dr. Diogo recommended a combination treatment of ADC therapy and immunotherapy. This is a relatively new treatment protocol that has been used successfully in Europe and the United States for cancers of this nature.

ADC (Antibody-Drug Conjugate)

ADC is a targeted therapy that recognizes cancer cells and delivers chemotherapy directly to them.

As a result, it typically causes less damage to healthy tissues than traditional chemotherapy.

B. Immunotherapy (Pembrolizumab)

Pembrolizumab works by stimulating the immune system to recognize and attack cancer cells.

It is administered through intravenous infusion.

Why This Combination?

The combination of ADC therapy and immunotherapy has shown promising results in certain patients with invasive urothelial cancer, improving disease control compared to some older treatment approaches.

Treatment Plan

Dr. Diogo hopes to begin treatment as early as this week. We are currently waiting for

the final cost estimate and other logistical details.

The first phase of treatment will last approximately three months and will consist of four cycles,

with weekly administrations. At the end of this period, another MRI will be performed to

assess how the carcinoma is responding to the treatment.
